TEACHING ARTISTRY

Secret Histories Documentary Theatre 2019

Thanks to Ping Chong & Co. and New Jersey Performing Arts Center I have been trained in creating documentary style plays for young and adult participants. My current residency is through NJPAC and it allows me to work with two sets of sixth grade classes in New Jersey to extract material to create a play based on identity, belonging and community while teaching the students elements of theatre and creative writing.

Speech for Actors 2016-2018

Facilitator. Using the Knight-Thompson method of Speech and the International Phonetic Alphabet, I teach 14-17 year old actors how to use formal and informal speech techniques in monologues and scene work to help deepen motivations and heighten the level of communication. For Rutgers Summer Acting

Conservatory, I teach 30-40 teenagers this method three times a week during the month long intensive.

New Play Development/Devised Play Workshops 2015-2019
Facilitator. Using a combination of technology, writing prompts, and instructor led movement exercises I help ensembles develop material for new plays as well as artistically enhance or restructure existing material in these devised works.

Shakespeare Workshops 2017-2019
Facilitator. Using a combination of training I personally received and the teaching artist workshops I audited for seven months at Shakespeare's Globe Theatre in London, I teach six different workshops that help new and experienced artist access and activate Shakespeare's classical text and story-telling methods.

Meisner Based Acting Workshops 2017-2019
Facilitator. Using modified Meisner-based acting techniques, I help BA theatre students and high school theatre students develop and perform in-class scenes, monologues and public performances.

Military Veteran Writing and Acting Workshops 2015-2019
Co-Facilitator. As the wife of a veteran, I have been invited into Veteran arts groups such as BEDLAM Outreach and Aquila Theatre to co-facilitate acting warm-ups that include voice, speech and Lecoq exercises. I have helped veterans develop original scripts that reflect how their experiences as soldiers relate to classical plays by Shakespeare, Aristophanes, Sophocles, Aeschylus and Euripides.
